FAITH MILESTONES

- **Baptism:** First Church Supports infant baptism and baptism for all believers.
- **Communion Instruction:** Classes are offered to second graders in September; older children who haven't yet participated are also welcomed. Holy Communion is offered to **all** on first Sunday's of the month.
- **Acolyte Training:** Fourth Graders and up are invited to become trained to acolyte in worship services, symbolically carrying the light of Christ into the sanctuary each week.
- **Bible Presentation:** Children in third grade and up are presented with their very own Bible each year, as part of an inter-generational Bible program.
- **Confirmation:** Rev. Tina Walker-Morin and Reagan Wilda co-lead a year long Confirmation Program for 7th and 8th graders (and older if youth have not yet been confirmed). The program includes service projects, worship participation, and retreats.
