## **Discussion Guide** (for use individually, as a family or in your small group)

Begin by reading Psalm 23:1-6 together. Focus specifically on verse 5.

Discuss any insights or observations you have from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared? Did anything stand out to you?

- A shift is made here from seeing the Lord as a Shepherd to now a great host. What is being celebrated at the table prepared by the Lord?
- Read Luke 15:20-24 & 32. What causes you to struggle believing that God accepts you as a son or daughter through repentant faith? What does it look like to live in view of God's delight over our salvation?
- Read Matthew 26:26-28. How has Jesus ultimately provided for us? What did he actually lay out on the table?
- Read 2 Corinthians 1:21-22. In what ways have you found refreshment and strength through God's Holy Spirit?
- Given that God celebrated over repentant sinners, that He provides himself as a full sacrifice, and that he refreshes and strengthens us, how does your life exemplify being completely satisfied in Him? How does your cup overflow?

Discuss any further insights together and close in prayer.
