Discussion Guide

(for use individually, as a family or in your small group)

Begin by reading Ephesians 2:1-9. Discuss any insights or observations you have from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared? Did anything stand out to you?

1. How does the world decide if someone or something is bad or good? To them, what makes somebody a good person? Do you think they would typically examine "every inclination of the heart" to determine if they are good or bad? Why or why not?
2. **Read Mark 7:20-23.** Where did Jesus say that evil is born and where it resides? When or how did you realize that you were sinful at the core and just as stained as any "bad" person?
3. **Read Romans 6:23 & Ephesians 2:12-13.** How wide is the chasm between people and God? Why do you think the world doesn't always feel like they are far from God?
4. **Read Romans 3:22-26.** How is God's mercy revealed and His justice satisfied? And how can we be made righteous?
5. **Read Romans 5:20-21 & Hebrews 4:16.** Why can we approach the throne of grace with confidence? How has God's mercy and grace shaped your hope?
