Discussion Guide

- **Read Deuteronomy 8:1-3 and John 6:48-51.** What does humility have to do with asking and receiving from God? Why is humility such a big deal to God? Do you find it difficult or easy to humble yourself when you pray? Explain.
- **Read Isaiah 1:18-20.** What does genuine repentance look like? Why is God able to "settle" the issue with sin we all have? Are your sins white as snow? Explain.
