Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)

Begin with prayer and read Psalm 58. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- **Read Romans 3:10-26.** What does injustice look like? How is injustice called out through the truth of scripture? How does God act justly? When we call out for justice, what should we call the corrupt to do?
- **Read Isaiah 10:1-3.** Who will ultimately hold the unjust accountable? How do you pray for justice to be served? How can you more proactively pray for God to restrain, remove, or even redeem the corrupt?
- **Read Revelation 19:11-16.** In what ways do you rejoice in the victory of Jesus right now? How does this passage, and the anticipation of the events listed, bring hope and rejoicing to the believer today?

Discuss any further insights together and close in prayer.
