Key Scriptures:

Psalm 55, 2 Samuel 15:1-6; 2 Samuel 15:30,31, 2 Samuel 17:1-7, 2 Samuel 17:23, John 13:17-30, Matthew 26:44-50

Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)

Begin with prayer and read Psalm 55. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- Have you ever felt 'stabbed in the back', betrayed by a friend? If not you probably know someone who has. How would you describe the pain? Was the relationship ever mended? How did that happen?
- David has been on both sides of betrayal. Have you ever betrayed someone? Is there an apology and reconciliation to be made?
- What actions or principles from Psalm 55 and/or Jesus and Judas can you use in your life for yourself or someone else to deal with betrayal?
