Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)

Begin with prayer and read Luke 7:36-8:3. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- **Read Romans 3:23.** What debt is owed by every person? How do people attempt to pay the debt owed to God? Why do they think they can pay it? Is there any way apart from Christ that we can become righteous? Explain.
- **Read Romans 3:21-28.** What is the currency needed to pay the debt of sin and death? How is this possible? Are there other strings attached? How have you responded to the King's offer of righteousness through faith?
- **Read Matthew 19:16-22.** Why did the rich young ruler go away sad? Why did Jesus reject the man's currency? Did the man think He loved God well? What did he actually lack in his love of God? Explain.

Discuss any further insights together and close in prayer.
