Begin with prayer and read Mark 4:1-20. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- **Read Jeremiah 15:16.** What is the seed referred to in the parable above? What did Jeremiah the prophet say about God's word? What is the connection between God's word and the one that bears His name?
- **Read Mark 4:15-20.** What are the different types of soils mentioned here? In what ways do you see these hearts in the world around you? What cultivates good heart soil?
- **Read Psalm 1:1-4.** How does a person produce a fruit like this? What does it look like to delight in the Lord's instruction? Have you experienced the fruit that comes from delighting in the Word? Explain.

Discuss any further insights together and close in prayer.
