Key Scriptures:

Isaiah 8:22-9:7, Isaiah 9:6, Isaiah 53:4-5, Matthew 11:28-30, Psalm 46:8-11, Isaiah 9:7, Psalm 2:7-12, 1 Thessalonians 4:16-18

Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)

Begin with prayer and read Isaiah 8:22-9:7. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

• Read Isaiah 53:4-5. People in the old testament longed for the fulfillment of this prophecy. What must their waiting have been like? What role did faith in this promise play? What gave them confidence in God's plan? How is Jesus the gift worth waiting for?

Read Matthew 11:28-30. What is Jesus' promise to those who
would come to Him? How does the rest He gives compare with other types of rest you've experienced?

Read Psalm 2:7-12. What is the warning found in this passage?
 What is the promise? What audience would find this passage threatening? What audience would find this passage to be a gift worth waiting for? In what ways does your life show your eager anticipation of Jesus' final reign?

Discuss any further insights together and close in prayer.
