**Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)**

**Begin with prayer and read Luke 19:28-44.** Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- **Read Matthew 20:17-19.** What did Jesus explain would happen? Why do you think the disciples may have misunderstood what Jesus was saying? What does Jesus' steadfastness in purpose reveal about how He feels toward you?
- **Read John 19:12-22.** Why did Pilate did not write what the chief priests wanted on the sign hanging above Jesus? How do you biblically see Jesus get praise even if mankind fails to offer it? How do you see this happening today?
- **Read Ezekiel 18:31-32.** In what ways is what Jesus did on earth misunderstood by humanity? What does God's call to repent and live reveal about the nature of His ultimate sacrifice? In what ways do you feel this personally?
