Key Scriptures:

Psalm 62:3-4, 9-10, Matthew 2:1-3, 16, Luke 11:39, Ephesians 2:8-9, Psalm 62:11-12,
Ephesians 2:1-9, Psalm 103:1-22

Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)

Begin with prayer and read Psalm 62:1-12. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- **Read Philippians 4:10-13.** Why should our confidence only be in the only God? What example did Paul set in this passage? Do you usually operate the same way or do certain circumstances cause you to lose sight of the Lord's care? Explain.
- **Read Matthew 2:1-3 and 16.** Why did it disturb Herod and all of Jerusalem when news of the birth of the King of the Jews had been brought? What was Herod's ultimate response? Do we rage against God being our only King, authority, and hope? Explain.
- **Read Psalm 103.** In what ways does God's faithful love satisfy? Does his faithful love have conditions, or does it run out? What does His faithful love say about Him? What should our response be?

Discuss any further insights together and close in prayer.
