Discussion Guide: (for use individually, as a family, or in a group)

Begin with prayer and read Psalm 66. Discuss any insights or observations you had from this week's message or from the scripture passages shared. Did anything stand out to you?

- **Read Psalm 150.** What does the Psalmist invite the hearer to do? What is the extent of where God is to be worshiped? With what? Who is expected to worship God? Why? What does such a wide invitation say about God's character?
- **Read 1 Peter 1:3-9.** What does the Lord's discipline and times of suffering bring about in the believer's life? What does discipline have to do with ownership? Why do we know we belong?
- **Read Psalm 86:8-13.** What personal commitment does the Psalmist make in this passage? Why? Can we make a similar one? Explain. What is your personal commitment to the Lord?
