The Ten Commandments Responsive

Leader: The first five Commandments as the head of the family should teach them in a simple way to the household. The First Commandment: You shall have no other gods. What does this mean?

Assembly: We should fear, love, and trust in God above all things.

L: The Second Commandment: You shall not misuse the name of the LORD your God. What does this mean?

A: We should fear and love God so that we do not curse, swear, use satanic arts, lie, or deceive by His name, but call upon it in every trouble, pray, praise, and give thanks.

L: The Third Commandment: Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. What does this mean?

A: We should fear and love God so that we do not despise preaching and His Word, but hold it sacred and gladly hear and learn it.

L: The Fourth Commandment: Honor your father and your mother. What does this mean?

A: We should fear and love God so that we do not despise or anger our parents and other authorities, but honor them, serve and obey them, love and cherish them.

L: The Fifth Commandment: You shall not murder. What does this mean?

C: We should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

Confession & Absolution

Leader: Let us come together to confess our sins before our Father and one another.

Assembly: Loving God, we come before you now to confess our sins and daily struggles. We acknowledge our need for your grace and forgiveness.

L: Through His Son, God has demonstrated His boundless love for His creation.

A: Yet, we hide from our brothers and sisters and we shy away from our calling into the Great Commission.

L: Through His Son, God demonstrated forgiveness and hope for a broken world.

A: Father, we rest upon your promises and we await your words of grace and hope.

(A silent moment for confession)

Leader: The promise of God is clear and true. Through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, we are given God's gracious gift of forgiveness. Being repentant, I proclaim to you the forgiveness of your sins. Joyfully forgiven, and through the power of the Holy Spirit, we share our joy and peace, our optimism and hope, our forgiveness and compassion, with every life we touch in the name of Jesus Christ.

First Reading

2 Timothy 2:1-13

My child, find your source of strength in the kindness of Christ Jesus. You've heard my message, and it's been confirmed by many witnesses. Entrust this message to faithful individuals who will be competent to teach others.

Join me in suffering like a good soldier of Christ Jesus. Whoever serves in the military doesn't get mixed up in non-military activities. This pleases his commanding officer. Whoever enters an athletic competition wins the prize only when playing by the rules. A hard-working farmer should have the first share of the crops. Understand what I'm saying. The Lord will help you understand all these things.

Always think about Jesus Christ, risen from the dead, the offspring of David. This is the Good News that I tell others. I'm suffering disgrace for spreading this Good News. I have even been put into prison like a criminal. However, God's word is not imprisoned. For that reason, I endure everything for the sake of those who have been chosen so that they, too, may receive salvation from Christ Jesus with glory that lasts forever. This is a statement that can be trusted:

If we have died with him, we will live with him. If we endure, we will rule with him. If we disown him, he will disown us. If we are unfaithful, he remains faithful because he cannot be untrue to himself.

L: This is the Word of God.

A: **Thanks Be To God!**

Luke 17:11-19

On the way to Jerusalem he was passing along between Samaria and Galilee. And as he entered a village, he was met by ten lepers, who stood at a distance and lifted up their voices, saying, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." When he saw them he said to them, "Go and show yourselves to the priests." And as they went they were cleansed. Then one of them, when he saw that he was healed, turned back, praising God with a loud voice; and he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan. Then Jesus answered, "Were not ten cleansed? Where are the nine? Was no one found to return and give praise to God except this foreigner?" And he said to him, "Rise and go your way; your faith has made you well."

L: This is the Gospel of our Lord!
