- **1)** Some people read with their <u>understanding closed</u>
 - "Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures." Luke 24:44-45 NLT
- 2) Some people read the word to **domesticate** it
- 3) Some people read the word to justify or control

4) God wants us to hear his word let it come alive and participate with it
