I. Who Are They?

Then those hidden ones are:

1. His own

“You were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your body.”

1 Corinthians 6:20 NIV

2. He hides them

“For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.” Colossians 3:3 NIV

“Rescue me from my enemies, O Lord, for I hide myself in you.” Psalms 143:9 NIV

II. Where He Hides. In The Safest Place In The Universe

1. In the pavilion of His grace

“For in the day of trouble he will keep me safe in his dwelling.” Psalms 27:5 NIV

2. In the secret of His tabernacle

“God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble.” Psalms 46:1 NIV

III. What They Are Hidden From

1. The pride of man

“In the shelter of your presence you hide them from the intrigues of men; in your dwelling you keep them safe from accusing tongues.” Psalms 31:20 NIV

2. The strife of tongues

“You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance.” Psalms 32:7 NIV

IV. The Privilege Enjoyed By The Hidden Ones

1. They are taught hidden wisdom.

“No, we speak of God's secret wisdom, a wisdom that has been hidden and that God destined for our glory before time began.” 1 Corinthians 2:7 NIV

“How great is your goodness, which you have stored up for those who fear you, which you bestow in the sight of men on those who take refuge in you.” Psalms 31:19 NIV

“He replied, “The knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them.” Matthew 13:11 NIV

2. They receive hidden riches.
