What mindset do you have?

WE OFTEN DON'T HAVE A GIFT PROBLEM, WE HAVE A MINDSET PROBLEM.

Paul tells us 2 things about this church:

- 1. THEY ARE EXTREMELY POOR, YET IRRATIONALLY GENEROUS.
- 2. THEY WERE EBDURING SEVERE TRIALS, YET **OVERFLOWING WITH JOY**.

What mindset do you have when it comes to giving?

A. THE BAG MINDSET: "WE DON'T HAVE ENOUGH!"

"You have sown much, and bring in little; you eat, but do not have enough; you drink, but you are not filled with drink; you clothe yourselves, but no one is warm; and he who earns wages, earns wages to put into a bag with holes."

Haggai 1:6 NKJV

B. THE BARN MINDSET: "WE HAVE MORE THAN ENOUGH!"

"The Lord will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hand to. The Lord your God will bless you in the land he is giving you." Deuteronomy 28:8 NIV

What happens with a barn mindset?

1. **WE GIVE**, WHY? **WE LOVE**.
