

Christmas In July - Discussion Questions

Part 03. Signal Path

(Hebrews 10:19–25)

1. Can you think of a time when pain, disappointment, or uncertainty made you question God's goodness or His plan for your life? What helped—or what could have helped—you stay connected to Christ instead of letting your circumstances define your reality?

2. The sermon compared our relationship with God to staying connected through a Signal Path. What kinds of "static" (such as guilt, fear, distraction, or sin) can interfere with your connection to God? What are some practical ways you can draw near to Him this week?

3. What is the difference between hoping that circumstances will improve and trusting that God will keep His promises? How does remembering that "the certainty of hope depends on the reliability of the Promiser" change the way you face difficult situations?

4. The sermon described the church as a community that creates a beautiful harmony when each person faithfully plays their part. How has another believer encouraged or strengthened your faith? This week, who is one person you can intentionally encourage so that the Signal Path continues through you into someone else's life?
