****The Chancel Choir's anthem "Lord, I Know I've Been Changed" is a spiritual that comes under the category of Sin/Conversion/Salvation in Eileen Gunther's book *In Their Own Words: Slave Life and the Power of Spirituals*. You will hear the choir repeatedly sing "the angels in heaven done signed my name." Angels signing or writing a person's name in heaven signifies that the individual is recognized, chosen, and guaranteed a place in eternal life. Rooted in the biblical concept of the "Book of Life," this phrase represents being saved, known intimately by God, and having experienced personal transformation, often associated with being "born again" or righteous.**

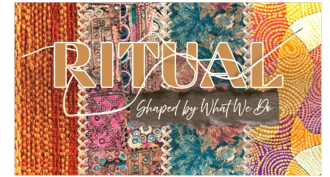
