Psalm 2 - God's Ultimate Rule

Why do people waste their time with futile plans? How to be wise: Act wisely, be warned, serve the Lord with fear, rejoice, submit.

Biblical Principle:

We can ignore God and cause problems, or we can submit to God and be blessed.

Psalm 3 - Confidence in Troubled Times

God is Your:

Help - Shield - Lifter of your head - Responder - Sustainer - Courage - Deliverer

Biblical Principle:

- Overcome fear by trusting in the Lord and depending on His divine intervention.
- Trusting in God is a channel for deliverance and blessing.

Psalm 4 - A Evening Prayer

"Be angry and do not sin (don't sin by letting anger gain control over you) on your bed, reflect in your heart and be still." (vs. 4)

Prayer: "Let the light of Your face shine on us, Lord." (vs. 6b)

<u>Biblical Principle:</u>

We can be confident that God listens to our prayers and answers when we call on Him.

<u>Psalm 5 - A Morning Prayer</u>

"My voice you shall hear in the morning. In the morning, I will direct it to you, and I will look up." (vs. 3)

- 1.Observe accurately
- 2. Wait patiently
- 3. Watch expectantly

Biblical Principle:

- God blesses, protects and surrounds the godly (those seeking after God).
- Pray for deliverance and serve God without distraction.
