# Delight - A Walk Through the Psalms - Psalms 1-30

### Psalm 26

When we are walking with the Lord it is easier to stand up against opposition and examination.

How to walk in integrity...10 things are listed in verses 4-8.

### **Biblical Principle:**

Bless the Lord publicly! Those who are determined to walk in integrity may be sure of God's care.

### Psalm 27

"Even if they attack me, I remain confident" (secure, bold, set one's hope in). -vs. 3 EVEN IF... "Yet I am confident that I will see the Lord's goodness while I am here in the land of the living." -vs. 13

## **Biblical Principle:**

Confidence in God grows with experiences with God. He offers help for today and hope for the future.

#### Psalm 28

In times of crisis respond to God with not only your prayers but also your statement of belief. When you have horizontal affliction — look for a vertical solution.

# **Biblical Principle:**

The Lord is your strength, your stronghold, and your salvation. Be assured of His help!

#### Psalm 29

We can trust God to give us both strength and peace to weather the storms of life.

# **Biblical Principle:**

"The Lord gives his people strength. The Lord blesses them with peace." -vs. 11 NLT "The Lord will give unyielding and impenetrable strength to His people; the Lord will bless His people with peace." -Amplified

### Psalm 30

In sorrow...SING! Don't be silent.
In sickness...PRAISE! Don't be shaken.
In suffering... THANK! Don't be sulky.

### **Biblical Principle:**

In God's perfect timing He will use things, turn things, switch things and revive things. Wait and Trust.
