We cannot wait to see what God has in store for Cultivate 2024!

DAY 1- APRIL 1

Pray that the Lord would prepare hearts- some to know the Lord for the first time, others to be refreshed by His love for them and all to connect with Jesus in a very personal way.

“Then I will give them a heart to know Me, that I am the Lord; and they shall be My people, and I will be their God, for they shall return to Me with their whole heart.”

Jeremiah 24:7

DAY 2- APRIL 2

As all the teachers, leaders, and teams prepare, pray they be ever mindful of the main purpose of this Cultivate weekend...that they point to Christ. Pray they would be guided to surrender all plans to His will and His purpose.

“And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.”

John 17:3

DAY 3- APRIL 3

Pray that each leader and team member be willing to sow bountifully this weekend. Pray that they sow joy in this journey of life, hope in Jesus, a closer personal walk with Him, and a warmth of friendship with one another.

"But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully, will also reap bountifully."

DAY 4- APRIL 4

Pray that any kind of anxiety or heavy hearts that women walk in with to Cultivate with are encouraged and reminded of the ultimate comfort and peace found only in Christ.

"We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ."

2 Corinthians 10:5

DAY 5- APRIL 5

Pray for the woman who is struggling to put all of her faith and trust in God. Pray that at Cultivate, she is reminded of His character and His goodness.

"The person who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence indeed is the Lord, is blessed."

Jeremiah 17:7

DAY 6- APRIL 6

Pray for the hearts of those who attend Cultivate. That they will be aligned with God and what He wants each woman to learn from the conference.

"Teach me your way, O Lord, that I may walk in your truth; unite my heart to fear your name."

Psalm 86:11 ESV

DAY 7- APRIL 7

Pray for all the workers preparing for Cultivate—those who are setting up the tables, the stage, and preparing the food as well as those that will be cleaning before and after. Pray that they will find strength and joy from the Lord while doing their work so that they also will be blessed by the conference.

"When anxiety was great within me, your consolation brought me joy."

Psalm 94:19

DAY 8- APRIL 8

Pray that this weekend all distractions would be left outside the church walls. Pray for focus solely on the Lord and the joy that comes from being in His presence!

"You make known to me the path of life; You will fill me with joy in Your presence, with eternal pleasures at Your right hand."

Psalms 16:11 NIV

DAY 9- APRIL 9

Pray this weekend will be a little preview of Heaven! Pray women experience joyful fellowship with one another as they glorify His name together!

“Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.”

Colossians 3:16 NIV

DAY 10- APRIL 10

Pray that the women of Cultivate would take every opportunity given for meaningful friendships despite differences, and instead be open to embrace them.

“Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another.”

1 John 4:11

DAY 11- APRIL 11

Pray that women would be encouraged by the Lord and one another during Cultivate and after.

“Encourage one another daily as long as it is ‘today,’ that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.”

Hebrews 3:13

DAY 12- APRIL 12

Pray for a moment to be still in the presence of the Lord. Find moments during the conference to stop and give thanks for what the Lord is doing in your life. Ask Him to help you be present during each moment of the conference, and for distractions of home, family, etc...be minimal.

*"Those who look to Him are radiant with joy; their faces will never be ashamed."
Psalm 34:5 (CSB)*

DAY 13- APRIL 13

Pray for great expectation. Has it been too long since you've had a sweet encounter with the Lord? Pray that the Cultivate Conference becomes a beautiful reminder of why we serve such a strong, and mighty God. Ask Him to rejuvenate a love for His work, His teachings, and His people.

*"Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to His power that is at work within us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever! Amen."
Ephesians 3:20-21*

DAY 14- APRIL 14

Pray that the woman waiting on God's timing would see the goodness in it. Pray that at Cultivate she sees that the Lord's plan is greater, and purposeful.

*"Wait for the Lord; be strong and take heart and wait for the Lord."
Psalm 27:14*

DAY 15- APRIL 15

Pray that the woman who feels alone or abandoned would see the Lord at work in her life. Pray that she would know that the Lord is with her everywhere she goes.

"Do not hide Your face from me, do not turn Your servant away in anger; You have been my helper. Do not reject me or forsake me, God my Savior."

Psalms 27:9

DAY 16- APRIL 16

Pray and ask the Lord to remove distractions as we prepare for the weekend and help us focus our hearts to hear from Him. Ask Him to show you thoughts that do not match His truth. Replace those thoughts with the truth found in His Word, and thank Him for graciously giving us truth to apply in our lives.

"Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable - if anything is excellent or praiseworthy - think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me - put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you."

Philippians 4:8-9

DAY 17- APRIL 17

Pray and ask the Lord to interrupt our earthly thoughts with heavenly thoughts. Ask the Lord to help us put down the weight of our circumstances and help us rest in His promises, His truth, and His provision. Ask Him to replace any burden we might have with His divine peace so we do not miss the joy of His presence.

“Come to Me all who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and my burden is light.”

Matthew 11:28-29

DAY 18- APRIL 18

Pray for the Worship Team... for excellence in performance, but more importantly, a humble heart of worship. That the time of worship would soften hearts and set the table for teaching.

“Sing a new song to Him; play skillfully on the strings, with a joyful shout.”
Psalms 33:3

DAY 19- APRIL 19

Pray against distraction—that everything goes smoothly leading up to the conference and any distraction that the enemy tries to use to prevent people from attending will be thwarted.

“Let your eyes look forward; fix your gaze straight ahead. Carefully consider the path for your feet, and all your ways will be established. Don’t turn to the right or to the left; keep your feet away from evil.”
Proverbs 4:25-27

DAY 20- APRIL 20

Pray for a reminder of the steadfast love and joy that comes from knowing Christ. Nothing in this life can take away the joy that coincides with the salvation we get from our Heavenly Father.

“So also you have sorrow now, but I will see you again, and your hearts will rejoice, and no one will take your joy from you.”

John 16:22 (ESV)

DAY 21- APRIL 21

Pray that each woman would experience fullness of joy that can only come from the Lord and that she would be reminded of their value and purpose in Christ.

“These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may be in you, and that your joy may be full.”

John 15:11 (ESV)

DAY 22- APRIL 22

Pray for the woman who feels like hope is so far away. Pray that she would find refreshment in the promise of God's loyal love and mercies that are new each morning.

“But this I call to mind, and therefore I have hope: The steadfast love of the LORD never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; they are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.”

Lamentations 3:21-23

DAY 23- APRIL 23

Pray for restoration in Jesus' name. Pray that each woman's relationship with Jesus be completely reconciled, restored, and refreshed, so that the fruit of the Spirit is cultivated and grown.

*"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law."
Galatians 5:22-23*

DAY 24- APRIL 24

Pray that the Lord would light our spiritual fires. Pray that we would seek Him actively through the spiritual disciplines of scripture reading, prayer, worship, evangelism, serving, and stewardship. Pray that women would be hungry for the things of the Lord. Joy is not cultivated passively, but through action.

*"Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer."
Romans 12:11-12*

DAY 25- APRIL 25

Pray for divine healing in all of the women joining us at Cultivate who are in need of the Lord to replenish their hearts, bodies and minds, who may have gone through or are currently going through a traumatic season and are having a difficult time experiencing joy through that season.

*"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds."
Psalm 147:3*

Day 26- APRIL 26

Pray that if there is anyone in need of forgiveness and softening of their heart, that the Holy Spirit would take over so that they would be able to receive His blessings of peace and joy. With this, pray that nothing would divide our hearts from experiencing the fullness of God at Cultivate.
