## The Bible Doesn't Say That "Everything Happens for a Reason" Romans 8:28

**Romans 8** <sup>28</sup> And we know that God causes all things to work together for good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose. (NASB)

- 1. God does not cause all things.
- 2. God uses all events in our lives together for good.

**Romans 8** <sup>26</sup> The Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know how to pray as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for us with groanings too deep for words; <sup>27</sup> and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to the will of God.

3. God makes this promise conditionally to Christians.

**Romans 8** <sup>28</sup> And we know that God causes all things to work together for <u>good to those who love God, to those who are called according to His purpose.</u>

**1 Peter 2** <sup>9</sup> But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

**Romans 8** <sup>29</sup> For those whom He foreknew, He also predestined to become conformed to the image of His Son, so that He would be the firstborn among many brethren.
