Psalm 11:3 Pastor Brian

Psalm 11 ³ When the foundations are being destroyed, what can the righteous do? (NIV)

1 Chronicles 16 ¹¹ Trust the Lord and his mighty power. Worship him always. (CEV)

How Do We Worship God in a crisis?

1. Praise God in spite of the circumstances.

Habbakuk 3 ¹⁷ Even though the fig trees have no blossoms, and there are no grapes on the vines; even though the olive crop fails, and the fields lie empty and barren; even though the flocks die in the fields, and the cattle barns are empty, ¹⁸ yet I will rejoice in the Lord! I will be joyful in the God of my salvation! (NLT)

Psalm 46 ¹⁰ Be still, and know that I am God! (NLT)

2. Ask God for strength and help.

Psalm 37 ³⁹ The Lord protects his people, and they can come to him in times of trouble. (CEV)

3. **Keep focused** on God and his promises.

John 16 ³³ I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world. (NIV)

Psalm 69 ³² Those who worship God will be encouraged. (TEV)
