**Hebrews 12** <sup>2</sup> We must keep our eyes on Jesus, who leads us and makes our faith complete. He endured the shame of being nailed to a cross, because he knew that later on he would be glad he did. (CEV)

## What are the benefits from Jesus' death and resurrection?

1. Complete forgiveness for everything.

**Colossians 2** <sup>13</sup> You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, he forgave all our sins. <sup>14</sup> He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross. (NLT)

2. Victory over sin.

**Romans 6** <sup>14</sup> Sin will have no power over you, because you aren't under Law but under grace. (CEB)

3. A great purpose for my life.

**2 Corinthians 5** <sup>15</sup> He died for everyone so that those who receive his new life will no longer live for themselves. Instead, they will live for Christ, who died and was raised for them. (NLT)

**Ephesians 1** <sup>11</sup> It's in Christ that we find out who we are and what we are living for. (MSG)

4. An **eternal place** in heaven.

**1 Peter 1** <sup>3</sup> Praise God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is so good, and by raising Jesus from death, he has given us new life and a hope that lives on. <sup>4</sup> God has something stored up for you in heaven, where it will never decay or be ruined or disappear. <sup>5</sup> You have faith in God, whose power will protect you until the last day. Then he will save you, just as he has always planned to do. (CEV)

**Romans 10** <sup>9</sup> If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved. (NLT)
