God is Good All the Time The Lord is my Shepherd

Psalm 23:1 Pastor Brian

Psalm 23 ¹ The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need. ² He lets me rest in green meadows; he leads me beside peaceful streams. ³ He renews my strength. He guides me along right paths, bringing honor to his name. ⁴ Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me. Your rod and your staff protect and comfort me. ⁵ You prepare a feast for me in the presence of my enemies. You honor me by anointing my head with oil. My cup overflows with blessings. ⁶ Surely your goodness and unfailing love will pursue me all the days of my life, and I will live in the house of the Lord forever.

Jesus is our shepherd & He provides everything **we need**.

Psalm 23 ¹ The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need. (NLT)

Why does God tell us not to worry?

1. Worrying is unhelpful.

Matthew 6 ²⁷ Can all your worries add a single moment to your life? (NLT)

2. Worrying is **not trusting in God.**

John 14 ¹ Don't let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God, and trust also in me. (NLT)

How do we trust God to meet our needs?

1. **Ask Him** everyday to be your shepherd.

Psalm 28 ⁹ Come save us and bless us. Be our shepherd and always carry us in your arms. (CEV)

2. Pray to Him and give Him your worries.

Philippians 4 ⁶ Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. ⁷ Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus. (NLT)

3. Trust Him one day at a time.

Matthew 6 ³⁴ So don't worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will bring its own worries. Today's trouble is enough for today. (NLT)
