God is Good All the Time "R & R"

Psalm 23:2 Pastor Brian

Psalm 23 ¹ The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need. ² <u>He lets me rest in green meadows; he leads me beside peaceful streams.</u>

This metaphor represents rest and refreshment.

Why do we feel the need to be so busy?

1. We base our worth on our work.

Psalm 127 ² It is useless for you to work so hard from early morning until late at night, anxiously working for food to eat; for God gives rest to his loved ones. (NLT)

2. We want more things, and we envy what others have.

Hebrews 13 ⁵ Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have... (NIV)

Ecclesiastes 4 ⁴ Then I observed that most people are motivated to success because they envy their neighbors. (NLT)

How do we find rest and refreshment?

1. Remember how valuable we are to God.

James 1 ¹⁸ He chose to give birth to us by giving us his true word. And we, out of all creation, became his prized possession. (NLT)

2. Remember the Sabbath.

Exodus 20 ⁹ You have six days each week for your ordinary work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a Sabbath day of rest dedicated to the Lord your God. (NLT)

Mark 2 27 The Sabbath was made to meet the needs of people, and not people to meet the requirements of the Sabbath. (NLT)

3. **Remember** to enjoy what God has already given us.

Ecclesiastes 4 ⁶ But better is resting with one handful than working hard for two fistfuls and chasing after wind. (CEB)

2 Corinthians 9 ⁸ God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others. (NLT)
