God is Good All the Time Your Rod & Staff

Psalm 23:4 Pastor Brian

Psalm 23 ¹ The Lord is my shepherd, I have everything I need. ² He makes me lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside still waters. ³ He restores my soul. He leads me in the right paths for His Name's sake. ⁴ Even when I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me. **Your rod and your staff comfort me.**

What is a rod and a staff?

- 1. A rod is used to guard and protect.
- **1 Samuel 17** ³⁴ But David said to Saul, "Your servant has been keeping his father's sheep. When a lion or a bear came and carried off a sheep from the flock, ³⁵ I went after it, struck it and rescued the sheep from its mouth. When it turned on me, I seized it by its hair, struck it and killed it." (NIV)
- 2. A staff is used to **lead and guide**.

Psalm 78 ⁵² But he brought his people out like a flock; he led them like sheep through the wilderness. (NIV)

3. Together, they **provide comfort**.

John 10 ¹⁰ But I came so that my sheep will have life and so that they will have everything they need. ¹¹ I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd gives his life for the sheep. (GW)

How does Jesus comfort us?

1. When we submit to Him, He gives us a **new life**.

Titus 3 ⁵ He saved us, not because of the righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He washed away our sins, giving us a new birth and new life through the Holy Spirit. (NLT)

2. When we are hurting, He shows **compassion**.

Matthew 9 ³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them because they were confused and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. (NLT)

3. When we lose our way, He finds us & brings us back.

Luke 15 ⁴ If a man has a hundred sheep and one of them gets lost, what will he do? Won't he leave the ninety-nine others in the wilderness and go to search for the one that is lost until he finds it? (NLT)

4. When we are attacked, He protects us.

Psalm 91 ¹⁴ The Lord says, "I will rescue those who love me. I will protect those who trust in my name. ¹⁵ When they call on me, I will answer; I will be with them in trouble. I will rescue and honor them." (NLT)
