# When Life Hurts Why does God allow Suffering?

John 16:33 Pastor Brian

**Psalm 22** <sup>1</sup> My God, my God, why have you forsaken me? Why are you so far from saving me, so far from my cries of anguish?... <sup>3</sup> you are enthroned as the Holy One; you are the one Israel praises. <sup>4</sup> In you our ancestors put their trust; they trusted and you delivered them. (NIV)

## 1. He did not create evil & suffering, but he permits it.

**Genesis 1** <sup>31</sup> Then God looked over all he had made, and he saw that it was very good! (NLT)

**Romans 3** <sup>23</sup> For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God's glorious standard. (NLT)

**Romans 5** <sup>12</sup> Therefore, just as sin entered the world through one man, and death through sin, and in this way death came to all people, because all sinned. (NIV)

**Ephesians 1** <sup>11</sup> He makes everything work out according to his plan. (NLT)

## 2. We are all victims of a broken world.

**Romans 8** <sup>21</sup> The creation looks forward to the day when it will join God's children in glorious freedom from death and decay. <sup>22</sup> For we know that all creation has been groaning as in the pains of childbirth right up to the present time. (NLT)

**John 16** 33 While you are in the world, you will have to suffer. But cheer up! I have defeated the world. (CEV)

**Galatians 6** <sup>7</sup> Do not be deceived: God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows. (NIV)

#### 3. God uses suffering to draw us closer to Him.

**James 1** <sup>2</sup> Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, <sup>3</sup> because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. <sup>4</sup> Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. (NIV)

### 4. God has an eternal plan for all of us.

**1 Corinthians 13** <sup>12</sup> For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. (NIV)

**Romans 8** <sup>18</sup> I consider that our present sufferings are not worth comparing with the glory that will be revealed in us. (NIV)

**Matthew 27** <sup>46</sup> About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, "Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?" (which means "My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?"). (NIV)

- 1. If you're presently suffering, remember that God is always with you. Trust Him.
- 2. Remember that this life is nothing when compared with eternity.
