Psalm 127 ³ Children are an inheritance from the Lord. They are a reward from him. (GW)

I. The Responsibility of Children

1. You need to obey your parents.

Ephesians 6 ¹ As for children, obey your parents in the Lord, because it is right. (CEB)

Proverbs 30 ¹⁷ An eye that mocks a father and rejects obedience to a mother, may the ravens of the river valley peck it out, and the eagle's young eat it. (CEB)

2. You need to honor your parents.

Ephesians 6 ² The commandment Honor your father and mother is the first one with a promise attached: ³ so that things will go well for you, and you will live for a long time in the land. (CEB)

3. We need to teach our children.

Proverbs 22 ⁶ Train children in the way they should go; when they grow old, they won't depart from it. (CEB)

4. We need to nurture our children.

Ephesians 6 ⁴ As for parents, don't provoke your children to anger, but raise them with discipline and instruction about the Lord. (CEB)

Colossians 3 ²¹ Parents, don't provoke your children in a way that ends up discouraging them. (CEB)

Proverbs 13 ²⁴ Those who withhold the rod hate their children, but the one who loves them applies discipline. (CEB)
