Live Your Calling CALLED TO BE LOVED

Life Group Notes - Week 2

The first purpose of our lives is **to let God love us**. In fact, our first calling is to enjoy a relationship with God. Understanding this will help us to discover why we're here on the earth – what our calling is. Enjoying a relationship with God is all about knowing and understanding how much He loves us, and returning that love to Him through worship!

This is only a guide – select the points you want to discuss.

> Read Ephesians 3:16-19

1. Paul prays that the Ephesians would know wide, how long, how high, and how deep God's love is for them. He loves us in the same manner. Share individually what these verses mean to you.

Follow up: How does understanding God's love for us help us to grow more in love for God?

Read Philippians 4:6-7

2. Many of you have been through some difficult times in recent days. Share with the group how living out this verse (not being anxious, praying with thanksgiving) has enabled you to experience God's peace through a recent trial.

Read Romans 8:38-39

3. This is one of the most beautiful verses in the Bible describing how much God loves us. It reminds us that no matter what happen to us, we can always count on God's love. Share with the group a recent experience in your life where God's love was made real to you.

Read Romans 12:1

4. As we finish this week, Romans 12:1 encourages us to "offer our bodies as a living sacrifice.." Share with the group how you live out this reality in your life.

Follow up: If worship is our response to God's love for us, what ways to you worship Him on a daily basis? (Remember worship is more than singing).
