Spring 2022 March Sunday School Lessons & Questions

March 13: A Life of Loyalty (John 13:21-27, 31-35)

Main Point: Connection to Christ calls for consistent loyalty.

- How would you define loyalty?
- In what ways did Jesus live for the Father's glory? How can we glorify God in our lives?
- What does it look like to love other people like Jesus loves us?

March 20: A Life of Trust (John 13:36-14:6)

Main Point: We can trust Jesus because He is the way, the truth, and the life.

- How have you grown in your trust in God?
- What are you most looking forward to about heaven? How should our future shape how we live today?
- How would you explain that Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life to someone who doesn't know Him?
- Spend some time praying for people in your life that need a relationship with Jesus.

March 27: A Life of Love (John 15:9-17)

Main Point: Remaining in Christ means our relationships are marked by love.

- What actions and attitudes are required to love sacrificially?
- What does it practically look like to love others the way Jesus loves us?
- Why is it challenging to express genuine Christian love?

Spring 2022 April Sunday School Lessons & Questions

April 3: A Life of Persecution (John 15:18-25; 16:1-4a)

Main Point: Living like Jesus means being treated as He was.

- What are some typical excuses people offer for rejecting Jesus?
- What opportunities do we have to make the gospel known?
- How do these verses encourage you to press forward as a Christ-follower?

April 10: A Life of Victory (John 16:19-22, 27-33)

Main Point: In Christ, we have victory over anything the world throws at us.

- What does it mean that Jesus has conquered the world?
- When have you seen Jesus turn sorrow into joy in your life?
- What hope might this passage give you in times of sorrow?

April 24: Stand Strong to the End (Matthew 24:1-14)

Main Point: Expect difficulty when you choose to follow Christ.

- What comforts does Jesus offer in these verses?
- What fears do you have about sharing the gospel?
- How can we help one another overcome these fears?
- What are some ways this passage encourages you to share the gospel?

Spring 2022 May Sunday School Lessons & Questions

May 1: Know What's Coming (Matthew 24:15-22)

Main Point: Even in the darkest times, God has not abandoned His people.

- How should knowing that Jesus is coming again one day impact how we live now?
- How can we make sure we are prepared for times of trouble?

May 8: Watch for Christ's Return (Matthew 24:23-31)

Main Point: When Christ returns, everyone will know it.

- How can we tell if teaching is false? How can we guard against it?
- How is Jesus' first coming different than His second?

May 15: Trust God's Timing (Matthew 24:32-41)

Main Point: Jesus is certain to return even though we don't know exactly when.

- When has God's Word proven true in your life?
- How does culture try to get us to doubt God's Word?
- What are some reasons why it is important for us to trust God's Word?

May 22: Keep Serving Faithfully (Matthew 24:42-51)

Main Point: Serve Christ faithfully as you wait for His return.

- What might keep us from faithfully serving Jesus?
- As we await His return, what has God called us to do?

May 29: Stay Prepared and Ready (Matthew 25:1-13)

Main Point: Grow in Christ as you wait for His return.

- Name and describe someone who has helped you spiritually in your faith with Jesus.
- How can you live with anticipation for Christ's return one day?
