Requirements for Team Members

- Students must attend a mandatory training session on Sunday, May 12, 3:30-5pm in the Youth Center, C179.
- Students must be able to share verbally a personal testimony of their walk with Jesus.
- Students must cooperate with other mission team members in sharing responsibilities both prior to and during the trip, while keeping a positive attitude.
- Students must be willing to step outside their comfort zones, trusting in the power of the Holy Spirit and relying on the support of their team.

Cost

- The total financial obligation for the trip is \$350 per person.
- A \$150 deposit is due with your registration form. The \$200 balance is due by April 28, 2024. Your deposit, future payments, and donations from family and friends are tax deductible and can be mailed to the Auburn UMC Youth Office, attn.: Jill Perry, PO Box 3135, Auburn, AL 36831. They may also be dropped off at the receptionist desk in Mathison Lobby or personally given to a youth staff member.
- All payments and donations are non-refundable.
- Due to the nature of charitable contributions and the financial obligations incurred by Auburn UMC, the No-Refund policy applies to donations, deposits and payments for students that have to withdraw from the trip.
