### From the Pastor ...

1 Peter 1:17 says, "And if you address as Father the One who judges impartially based on each one's work, you are to conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your temporary residence."

Several key words and phrases stand out to me in this verse:

"If you address as Father"- This phrase reminds us that we can have a relationship with Almighty God. When we put our faith in Him, we are adopted as sons and daughters in His family. We can know God!

"the One who judges impartially"- This phrase is a clarifying clause referring to God the Father. This same God that we have a relationship with is the One who will judge all of humanity. This phrase also helps us understand that His holiness and faithfulness is the standard, and nothing can change that.

"conduct yourselves in fear"- Simply put, be obedient. Have enough reverential fear of God that it compels you to live faithfully and obediently.
