Hillside Groups:

Hillside Groups interested in meeting onsite at Hillside during the week, contact Pastor Renée (Renee@hillsidemoncton.org) for the details of the regulations required.

Off-site Groups can either meet on Zoom, outdoors, or in a controlled public venue (e.g. restaurant, coffee shop or other place where full vaccination with a government issued ID is required.)

*Sunday gatherings onsite

- Sundays when we are on onsite, we'll have one service at 10am in the auditorium, the Vibe for students (Grade 6 to 12), and Kids Programming (Waumba Land, KidZone, Launch.) In the weeks ahead we will consider adding more services as needed to allow for physical distancing, based on numbers in attendance onsite and volunteer availability.
 - The 10am service will continue to be live-streamed (<https://hillsidemoncton.online.church/>) & we understand this is an important community and option for our Hillside family.
- You will **not** be asked to show vaccination status onsite. If you are experiencing any Covid symptoms or have been asked to self-isolate, we ask you to please not come onsite, and engage with us online instead.
- Everyone must wear a mask, at all times (children under 2 are exempt.)
- Physical distancing will be maintained onsite (except in the Kids designated bubbles.) Please help maintain physical distancing in the lobby, auditorium, and in the Vibe. Our numbers will be capped to ensure physical distancing can be maintained.
- Congregational singing will not be encouraged.
- Kids Programming will require pre-registration(<https://www.hillsidemoncton.org/>) and kids will be kept in separate bubbles. Kids also are to wear masks at all times (children under 2 are exempt.)
- The Vibe (Grade 6 to 12) will require pre-registration (<https://www.hillsidemoncton.org/>) Masking and physical distancing will be maintained in The Vibe. Pictures of where students are seated in The Vibe will be taken each Sunday, to be used should the need for contact tracing arise.
- In the auditorium, you will be asked to fill out a short paper form (at your seat) that gives us your contact information and identifies the row you sat in. This information will be kept confidential, and only shared with Public Health if request for contact tracing. Pre-registration isn't required at this time in the auditorium but is required for Kids Ministry (Birth to Grade 5) and The Vibe (Grade 6 to 12) on our website. (<https://www.hillsidemoncton.org/>)
