MESSAGE NOTES

"KNOWING THE UNKNOWABLE GOD" - John 8:12-36

INTRODUCTION: How can we know God, when he is up there in the light, and we are down here in the dark?

- Two human answers: arrogance or ignorance!
- God has an answer:

"When the time had fully come, God sent his son." (Galatians 4:4) "In him was life, and that life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness." (John 1:4-5)

1. Jesus is the light of God in our darkness.

- a. Jesus makes the astonishing claim.
 - I am the One light of the world. (v.12)
- I am the One who is the light of life. (v.12)
- b. Jesus defends the astonishing claim.
 - I am the One from heaven. (v. 14)
 - I am the One sent from the Father. (v. 16, 18)
 - I am the One Son of the Father. (v. 19)
 - I am the One to believe in for salvation from sin. (v. 21, 24, 26)

2. The people reject his claim of light and remain in darkness.

- a. They had no idea who Jesus was. (v. 14)
- b. They were judging by human standards. (v. 15)
- c. They did not truly know God the Father. (v. 19)
- d. They could not follow him to heaven. (v. 21)
- e. They did not understand. (v. 27)
- f. They ask an obvious question: "Who are you?" (v. 25)

We have a stalemate! What will break it open? What will open eyes? (v. 28)

3. All will know Jesus is the light of God in our darkness when He is lifted up!

- a. Being "lifted up" means exaltation.
 - This is the meaning of death on the cross.
 - This is the meaning of salvation on the cross. (a double meaning)
 - This is the meaning of the resurrection. (triple meaning)
 - This is the meaning of the ascension. (quadruple meaning!)
- b. Being "lifted up" validates / proves all Jesus' claims.
 - Jesus is the One he said he was.
 - Jesus is the One / the Light of God.
 - Jesus is One with God.
 - Jesus is the One who brings salvation from God.

GOD'S LIGHT LIT UP OUR DARKNESS WHEN JESUS WAS LIFTED UP.

CONCLUSION: The Resurrection happened at dawn.
