"NO WIND, NO FIRE!" Acts 2:1-21

INTRODUCTION: "Will God dwell on earth?" We feel the "Great Divide.""

How do we live on this earth with all of our current trials, questions, and transitions with Jesus in heaven after His ascension?

1. THE SPIRIT CAME TO GATHER THE FIRST DISCIPLES.

- a. The Spirit came on the day of Pentecost ("fiftieth").
- b. The Spirit came suddenly.
- c. The Spirit came with a sound LIKE wind.
- d. The Spirit came from heaven.
- e. The Spirit filled all.
- f. The Sprit came with a sight LIKE fire.
- g. The Spirit filled each one individually. The Holy Spirit...
 - ...initiates our salvation
 - ...gives us assurance of our salvation
 - ...is the presence of Christ and points to Christ
 - ...leads us to intimacy with God
 - ...reveals and illuminates the truth of Scripture
 - ...sanctifies us, makes us holy, Christ-like
 - ...produces the fruit of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control
 - ...empowers us
 - ...makes us part of His Body the church
 - ...gifts us for service to others

2. THE SPIRIT CAME TO GATHER A CROWD.

- a. The crowd gathered at the sound.
- b. The crowd gathered at the languages.
- c. The crowd is from the ends of the earth.
- d. The crowd gathered for the message.
- e. The crowd gathered with a dual response.
 - (1) Bewildering amazement wanting more explanation.
 - (2) Ridicule wanting less.

3. THE SPIRIT CAME TO GATHER MORE DISCIPLES.

- a. Peter deals with the ridiculous first.
- b. Peter preaches the very first gospel sermon.
 - (1) This is The Day of the Spirit.
 - (2) This is The End that is near.
 - (3) This is all about Jesus the Lord and Christ.
- c. The Spirit adds about 3000 disciples.

THE SPIRIT OF CHRIST CAME TO FILL US TO FILL THE EARTH WITH THE GOSPEL OF CHRIST: FROM THE ENDS OF THE EARTH TO THE END OF TIME.

APPLICATION: For individuals and as a church engaging in Solemn Assembly.

CONCLUSION: Not 'wailing' but 'singing' on Pentecost.
