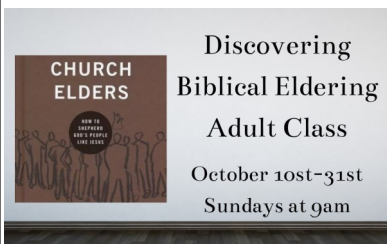

MESSAGE NOTES

» *disciple* » of Jesus Respond to Him a Certain Way " Luke 5:1-39

INTRODUCTION: *What is the right way to respond?*

REVIEW:

- Lk 1-3: Luke has given His birth and credentials: His coming is not normal: He is the Messiah in a Manger! He is Son of God, Son of Man. His baptism and temptation validate all the titles and truths.
- Lk. 4: His mission is to bring God's salvation to the 'poor': that is everyone who needs salvation (which is everyone!).

Luke 5 ***What is the proper response to Jesus: The Messiah on Mission?***

1. Jesus is THE GREAT TEACHER OF GOD'S WORDS for the crowds. (1-3)

The Proper Response: Enthralled listening!

2. Jesus is THE ALL-KNOWING MASTER OF CREATION calling the fishermen. (4-11)

The Proper Response: Stunned humility! Astonishment with total surrender!

3. Jesus is THE ALL-POWERFUL HEALER for the leper. (12-16)

The Proper Response: Courageous faith to bow in respect and beg.

4. Jesus is THE FORGIVER OF SIN for the paralytic. (17-26)

The Proper Response: Active faith for forgiveness with praise.

5. Jesus is THE GRACIOUS MASTER for the tax collector. (27-29)

The Proper Response: Full surrender and following (with friends).

6. Jesus is THE DOCTOR for the notorious sin-sick. (30-32)

The Proper Response: Feast and fellowship.

7. Jesus is THE BRIDEGROOM OF THE NEW COVENANT for his new people. (33-39)

The Proper Response: Rejoice with the bridegroom and make new wineskins.

WHEN THE MESSIAH IS ON MISSION TO BRING IN HIS MISFITS, I MUST RESPOND BY BEING OVERWHELMED BY HIS MAGNIFICENCE.

Are you underwhelmed? Are you just 'whelmed'? Are you overwhelmed?

CONCLUSION: Wouldn't you love to meet Jesus' misfit people someday?
