INTRODUCTION: *When will this stop? What is God doing?*

So much constant evil, foolishness, and groaning.

*How does the disciple of Jesus respond and live in light of it all?
And for FBC: how do we respond and live as a church body of believers?*

“The only way to make sense of today is to know where life is headed in the future.”
(This is not about charts, but hearts.)

1. WE CAN KNOW THE NATURE OF THE KINGDOM. (chapter 17)

- The kingdom has come in Christ when he came the first time.
- The kingdom is still coming in Christ when he comes the second time.
- That coming will be dramatic, sudden, surprising, deadly.
- Jesus Christ, the Son of Man is the focus of the present and future kingdom.

2. WE CAN KNOW THE EVENTS OF THE FUTURE. (chapter 21)


- Jesus predicts the general signs before the end.

general signs: *deceivers, wars, global conflict, natural disasters - heaven signs*

- Jesus predicts some specific signs in Jerusalem before the end.

specific signs: *persecution, betrayal, death, hatred, Jerusalem destroyed - heaven signs*

- Jesus predicts the final signs of the coming of the Son of Man at the end.



3. WE CAN KNOW HOW TO LIVE NOW IN LIGHT OF THE END.

- Stand firm.
- Stand before.
- Stand up.
- Stand behind.
