INTRODUCTION: Let's get busy! That's what we are especially good at. With urgency, strategy, energy, synergy, mission and vision!

 - a. The best place.
 - b. The amazing blessing.
 - c. The blameless walk.

- "People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart." (1 Samuel 16:7)
