

# 432 GROUPS

**FOUR** BOLD Habits lived by **THREE** people meeting **TWO** times a month. After 12 months each person finds two people to create new 432 groups with.

## **MEETUP STRUCTURE** (1 hour – anytime, anyplace, any pace)

For the first meeting, spend your time sharing how you each came to Christ.

- **Prior to each meeting:**

- Develop a \*SENT List and begin living the \*BOLD Habits. (\*see page 2)
- Read 1 chapter of John and journal Jesus' posture (attitude/approach) and priorities in each situation.

- **20 minutes – Story**

- What was your High and Low since we last met?
- Share how you lived out one of the BOLD Habits toward other followers of Christ and those on your SENT List since we last met?
- Share how you followed through with what the Spirit led you to do since we last met?

- **20 minutes – Study**


- Discuss what God has taught you from the book of John about Jesus that you need to live out in your life toward followers of Christ and those on your SENT List.

- **10 minutes – Sharpening**

- Share what the Spirit is leading you to do next?
- If you lead a ministry area, share any training or insight with regards to that area.

- **10 minutes – Support**

- Pray for each other and the next steps each will be taking.
