What Does the Holy Spirit Do? (Part 1) Various Verses

*These questions are provided to lead the group in **applying** the teaching from Sunday. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in being a doer of God's Word. Challenge each other and be vulnerable as God works IN and THROUGH you together.*

1. Who has God placed on your heart to invite to The Table (1-Year Rally)? Have you had any table meetings yet (Church? Community? Cultures?)? If so, how's it going?
2. Have you ever sensed a prompting that you thought was direction from the Holy Spirit? Share the experience with the group and what you thought about it.
3. Were there any moments this past week when the UnSeen Holy Spirit was Seen through your attitude or actions? Share.
4. The Holy Spirit is involved in preparing us to follow Jesus. Read John 16:7-8. What role does the Holy Spirit play in unbelievers' lives (and believers')? Share when you first experienced this work of the Holy Spirit in your life and how you responded.
5. Read John 15:26. Being convicted of sin is not enough. What does the Holy Spirit do to provide the way out of judgment? How did this happen for you? Did the Holy Spirit use someone or something to direct you to the answer?
6. The Holy Spirit is also involved at the very point of us believing in and following Jesus. Read Titus 3:4. What role does the Holy Spirit play in our conversion? In what way does this imagery help you better perceive the role of the Holy Spirit in your salvation?
7. Read 1 Corinthians 12:13. Describe what happens at conversion when we experience the baptism of the Holy Spirit (even though we are unaware). Where does the Spirit place us? Discuss how this act highlights the importance of being part of a church.
8. Read John 14:17 and Romans 8:9. Where does the Holy Spirit dwell? What does it mean to you personally for the Holy Spirit to live inside of you? What are the benefits?
9. The Holy Spirit is also involved in the process of us following Jesus and living the Christian life. Read 2 Corinthians 3:18, 1 Thessalonians 4:7-8, and Romans 8:11-14. Describe what the Holy Spirit does in the lives of Christians. Share how you have experienced this in your own life.
10. Discuss: "The Christian life is impossible to live in my own power." Agree or disagree? How does this statement resonate with your experience? Talk about the importance of the Holy Spirit in our lives. How can you involve him more in your life this week?
11. Read John 14:12. Jesus makes this statement before he starts teaching about the Holy Spirit. What did he mean? How can the Holy Spirit make this true in your life?
12. How can this group pray for you and our church this week? Pray for people to invite to your Church Table, Community Table, and Cultural Table.
