What is the Fruit of the Holy Spirit? Galatians 5:13-26

*These questions are provided to lead the group in **applying** the teaching from Sunday. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in being a doer of God's Word. Challenge each other and be vulnerable as God works IN and THROUGH you together.*

1. Who has God placed on your heart to invite to The Table (1-Year Rally)? Have you had any table meetings yet (Church? Community? Cultures?)? If so, how's it going?
2. **Read Galatians 5:13-15.** What does Paul mean when he says, "You were called to freedom"? How is this freedom different from a license to sin?
3. How does serving one another in love (vs. 13) connect to living in freedom?
4. **Read Galatians 5:16-18.** How does walking in the Spirit keep us from gratifying the desires of the flesh?
5. What does Paul mean in (vs. 18) when he says, "But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law"?
6. **Read Galatians 5:19-21.** What does Paul mean when he says, "I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God"?
7. Go through each act of the flesh and share the aspect(s) of the fruit of the Spirit (5:22-23) that counter them.
8. **Read Galatians 5:22-26.** Share how Love, Joy, and/or Peace can lead to each of the other six aspects of the Fruit of the Spirit. Be specific.
9. What is the significance of the Fruit of the Spirit being singular (one fruit) rather than plural (multiple fruit)?
10. Which aspect of the fruit of the Spirit (love, joy, peace, etc.) do you find most challenging to submit to, and why?
11. How do the acts of the flesh enslave us? How does the fruit of the Spirit free us?
12. How can you practically "walk by the Spirit" in your daily life this week?
13. How can this group pray for you and Life Church this week? Pray for people to invite to your Church Table, Community Table, and Cultural Table.
