Friends: Encouraging One Another (Relational)

Live a Shared Life

Daniel 1-6; Acts 2:41-47

These questions are provided to lead the group in applying the teaching from Sunday. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in being a doer of God's Word. Challenge each other and be vulnerable as God works IN and THROUGH you together.

1. Who has God placed on your heart to invite to The Table (1- Year Rally – Church, Community, Cultures)? If you have already had some table meetings, how has it impacted you?
2. What impact do you think Daniel's community (Friends) had on his life? Share the impact your community has had on you.
3. **Read Acts 2:41.** Discuss how your group is devoted to these things. Where could your group grow?
4. **Read Acts 2:42-47.** Share the results of their devotion listed in this passage. How have you seen these in your group? How are these things growing the group to "enjoy the favor" of new people?
5. **Read Acts 2:44, 1 Corinthians 1:9, Philippians 1:4-5, & Romans 15:27.** The word for common, fellowship, partnership, and shared are all forms of the Greek word, Koinonia. Koinonia is shared life united by what is held in common and guided by a unified mission. What stands out most to you in this definition of Koinonia? Why is that aspect important?
6. What are some things that can stand in the way of Koinonia in the church?
7. Give examples of groups that share an identity. What impact should our shared identity as the church have on us?
8. What devotions can sidetrack the church from sharing those mentioned in Acts 2:41. How do we combat this?
9. What are some resources that this group shares with one another?
10. How is this group sharing the mission of God together?
11. **Read 1 Corinthians 12:26.** Share a time someone shared in your suffering. What does this look like as a group?
12. How is God spiritually forming you with this group?
13. Which of the shared life aspects is most difficult for you? For the group? How might this group step into deeper koinonia?
14. How can this group pray for you and our church this week? Pray for those at your Church Table, Community Table, and Cultural Table.
