**JOB SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:**

**1. Sunday Service Production**

- Arrive for 7:00 AM call time to prepare audio systems for the day's services.
- Mix audio for the livestream during the 9:00 AM and 10:45 AM services, ensuring clarity, balance, and consistency for the online audience.
- Start and stop multitrack recordings for each service.
- Configure and operate autotune as needed during services.
- Monitor livestream audio throughout the service and adjust as needed to maintain broadcast-quality sound.

**2. Production Support**

- Fill in for Front of House (FOH) mixing when needed.
- Collaborate with worship and production teams to execute services with excellence.
- Troubleshoot audio, signal flow, and routing issues when they arise.

**3. Post-Service Responsibilities**

- Ensure all multitrack recordings are properly saved and labeled.
- Power down and secure audio equipment after the final service.

- Strong live audio mixing experience (portfolio or recordings of previous work preferred)
- Working knowledge of audio networking

- Reliable and punctual with the ability to consistently meet early Sunday call times
