



Made Ya Look!

These questions are provided to lead the group in applying the teaching from Sunday. Allow the Holy Spirit to guide you in being a doer of God's Word. Challenge each other and be vulnerable as God works IN and THROUGH you together.

1. Who has God placed on your heart to invite to The Table (1-Year Rally)? Have you had any table meetings (Church? Community? Cultures?)? If so, how's it going?
2. Have you ever experienced a time when you felt overwhelmed and unseen? Maybe in your family? At work? At church?
3. Genesis 1:27 reads, "God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them." What does it mean to be created in the image of God?
4. Read Luke 8:44-46. Jesus sees this woman who everyone else sees as a sinner. Is there something in your past that you are needing to take to Jesus' feet? Something that is holding you back from seeing the worth God sees in you?
5. Read Romans 12:1. What does "living sacrifice" mean? How would the believers in Rome reading this letter from Paul understand "living sacrifice"? Is there a sacrifice you are currently offering as your "true and proper worship"?
6. Read Ruth 1:8-18. How did Naomi try to care for her daughters-in-law? What was Ruth's response? Have you been on the receiving end of sacrifice? Have you offered yourself as a sacrifice to another?
7. The term "kinsman redeemer" is seen in Ruth 2:20 and Ruth 3:9. What does this mean? How does this relate to how Jesus redeems us?
8. Mother's Day is a holiday where we celebrate moms, but sometimes this day can come with pain. Read Isaiah 43:2. Is there a pain that you are walking with Jesus through that you'd like to discuss?
9. Read Proverbs 12:18. Share examples in your life where you've seen this truth exemplified.
10. God sees our pain, but he also sees what can come out of our pain. While this does not remove the pain, knowing something can come from the pain can bring peace. Do you have a time in your life when you can see God use your pain?
11. How can this group pray for you and our church this week? Pray for people to invite to your Church Table, Community Table and Cultural Table.
