# **Spirit** Corner Submitted by Don Uglow

Last month we reviewed that John Wesley's heart was "strangely warmed". John (the founder of the Methodist Church) was attending the meeting of a society on Aldersgate Street, London, England in May of 1738. He was describing the change which God works in the heart, through faith in Christ and he stated, "I felt my heart strangely warmed."


Today, there are several available books written about that experience and Mr. Wesley credits "the Holy Spirit at work" in creating that event......suffice it here, to say that it was a supernatural experience for the believers. After it happened, John Wesley was spurred on to preach all over England and subsequently the new colonies in America. The "Helper" (Holy Spirit), motivated him to save souls and multiply the numbers of Christians. His movement became known as "The Methodist Church".

Note the above reference to "The Helper". This is one of the descriptive terms that Jesus uses for The Holy Spirit, just prior to his Ascension.....(John 14: 25, 26, "I have told you while I am still with you. The Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and make you remember all that I have told you." Jesus directs the Disciples toward the Holy Spirit who has come to help US.

The Bible tells us that the Holy Spirit arrived on the day of Pentecost. He had come to *indwell*, in the believers but every one of the believers was not indwelled by the Holy Spirit at the same time. It started with those in the Upper Room and shortly afterward, other believers became filled with the Holy Spirit and in stages, it slowly swept over the (then) Christian community.

So it follows, that as Disciples, **WE** need to begin to focus on the Helper. Christians and he is waiting for us to submit to him, asking for his help. He is patient and also powerful but he does not take action until he is invited to do so. As Disciples, we need him to help us carry out the Mission of Christ United Methodist Church, here in Lafayette, Indiana! We cannot do it by ourselves and we need to get to know the Helper, just as we need to get to know anyone, prior to asking them to help us get something done!!!!

When we combine these steps and then take action,.....all things are possible. The Helper will get involved!
