Introduction

Discussion Questions

Speaking of personal experience Scott stated that you cannot debate experience in relation to an encounter with Jesus. Do you agree or disagree with this? Why?

How does the Apostle Paul's encounter demonstrate this principle (See Acts 9:1-31 & Phil. 3:4-6)?

"When your posture of repentance intersects with God's faithfulness - you experience transformation."

How would you define your journey of faith thus far - one centred on personal belief or personal experience? How does that definition shape your life?

Understanding that the Levitical system was established by God; what deeper principle is David expressing about God's heart in Psalm 51:17 in relation to sacrifices? (See 1 Samuel 13).
