Sermon Series: Darkness Turned to Life

Sermon Title and Date: Week 1 – Easter Sunday; April 20, 2025

Summary

This Easter sermon focuses on the contrast between darkness and light, using Mary Magdalene's experience at Jesus's tomb as a central narrative. The pastor emphasizes how Jesus transforms darkness into light in our lives, and how we need to experience darkness to truly appreciate the light. The message culminates in explaining how believers are called to be light to others in a dark world.

- What resonates with you about Mary Magdalene's experience at the tomb?
- How have you experienced Jesus bringing light into a dark situation in your life?
- Why do you think we need to experience darkness to truly appreciate the light?
- In what ways can believers be 'the light of the world' in practical terms?
- How does the resurrection of Jesus give us hope in dark times?
- What prevents us from reaching for the light of Jesus when we're in darkness?
- How can we help others find light in their darkness?

Life Application

This week, identify one person in your life who might be going through a dark time. Make a specific plan to be a light in their life through encouragement, support, or practical help.
