The September Grub on the Run, held on Tuesday, September 28, continued to push up the record pace for the number of meals served. Your Grub servants gathered at Sulphur Grove between 4:45pm and 6:30pm, and they served and handed out 271 dinners. Each diner enjoyed a take-and-eat meal consisting of Sloppy Joe fixins', bun, chips, applesauce, and a brownie provided by your Grub on the Run servants. We hope you enjoyed eating your Sloppy Joe as much as we enjoyed serving it to you. One guest remarked that he was looking forward to his sandwich because had not had a Sloppy Joe for years, because his wife had stopped making it for him.

The number of meals served continues to raise the record pace of more than 229 meals served each month. Even though we are maintaining a record pace for this year, there is always a greater need and always, always room for more people to join Grub on the Run. We were especially pleased with the number of first-timers who drove through for a meal in September. We hope that they will join us again on **October 26th** for our next Grub on the Run. We will be serving a menu of spaghetti, salad, bread, and a brownie.
