## **HOLDEN CHAPEL TURNED AROUND 1950-1951**

At the same time the upper level of the brick addition was completed, Holden Chapel was turned 180 degrees. Worship was held in the new basement social hall during this construction. The beautiful stained glass Good Shepherd window replaced the original entry doors on the south wall. The Chancel included pulpit, lectern, communion table, and choir loft with organ, flanked by the pastor's study on the west and an office for a church secretary on the east, all on the south end of the room.

A partial wall with folding doors replaced the north wall and allowed the new Sunday School room to be used as overflow seating for Worship. The new main entrance, with narthex and steps to access the basement level, completed the east side of the building.

Many generous gifts continued to pour in, including \$5,000 from the Women's Bible Class. The two-story brick addition and the remodeled sanctuary cost a total of \$60,700. Dedication was June 25, 1951. Seating capacity in the turned around sanctuary plus the overflow was 200.

Gene Lehman holds the distinction of being the only man married at both ends of Holden Chapel. Gene and Charlotte Oram were married in the original Holden Chapel August 27, 1946, by Rev. George R. Jacoby. Later, after Charlotte's death, Gene and Donna Scott were married in the 'turned around' Holden Chapel March 3, 1999. Officiating Pastor Jack Drodge quipped to Gene, "Now you have burned the candle at both ends!"

Your Grub servants gathered at Sulphur Grove between 4:45pm and 6:30pm where they served and handed out 261 dinners. Each diner enjoyed a take-and-eat meal consisting of spaghetti, undressed green salad, bread, and dessert provided by your Grub on the Run servants.

The number of meals served continues to raise the record pace approaching almost 233 meals served each month. Even though we are maintaining a record pace for this year, there is always a greater need and always room for more people to join Grub on the Run. We hope that our first-time attendees and many others will join us on **November 16** for our next Grub on the Run. We will be serving a menu of turkey & dressing, gravy, mashed potatoes, cranberry sauce, green beans, and a pumpkin dessert.

Remember the Grub meal is for EVERYONE so y'all come. Also remember that you, too, can have a Thanksgiving feast with your neighbors. Just pick up a couple of extra meals and invite a couple of neighbors to join you as you dine and Fellowship together and thank God for all that He has done for you.
